AN ORDINANCE FOR FIRE PROTECTION

ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 10

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE PROVIDING OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES TO THE TOWN OF CORYDON BY THE HARRISON TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the legislative governing body of the Town of Corydon in the State of Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the Harrison Township Fire District was recently created by Harrison County for the purposes of providing vital fire protection services and other public health and safety services to Harrison Township, Harrison County, Indiana to which the Town of Corydon is located, and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Town Council for the Town of Corydon, Indiana to provide for the public safety of all citizens and visitors of the Town, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with I.C. 36-8-11-4, a municipality may be included in a fire protection district for the purposes of providing fire protection services by the adoption of an ordinance by the municipality consenting to such protection, and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the Town Council that fire protection services are vital to the public health and safety of the citizens of the Town of Corydon and that the Harrison Township Fire District is the most appropriate entity to provide such services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Town Council for the Town of Corydon hereby consents to the inclusion of its territory to be included in the district of the Harrison Township Fire District and that the Harrison Township Fire District shall provide such fire protection services to the citizens and businesses of the Town of Corydon until further action is taken by the Town Council in accordance with Indiana Code .

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective after passage by the Corydon Town Council and publication of this Ordinance as required by law.
